

The Monhegan School Committee hereby adopts the system of learning results and the Maine Department of Education's applicable rules. The learning results system is intended to serve as a foundation for education reform and to promote and provide assessment of student learning, accountability and equity. The Committee recognizes that the legislative intent of the learning results system is to provide children with schools that reflect high expectations and create conditions where these expectations can be met.

The Committee understands that the implementation of the learning results system has broad implications for the school, including curriculum, budget, professional development, students assessment, professional assessment, and graduation requirements. Therefore, the Committee is committed to examining its policies to ensure that they are consistent with the intent and goals of the learning results system. This will require a concerted and coordinated effort involving the Committee, Superintendent, teacher, parents, students, and the community.

The Committee directs the Superintendent to develop a plan and timeline for implementing the learning results system and any appropriate administrative procedures. The Committee further directs the Superintendent to report to the Committee on a regular basis (quarterly) on progress toward implementing the learning results system.
