1st/2nd/3rd YEAR PROBATIONARY TEACHER'S EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT

The Monhegan Plantation School Committee hereby agrees to employ _____ and _____ hereby agrees to serve under the direction of the School Committee and Superintendent of Schools, as a teacher of elementary grades nursery school to grade eight; in the public school of Monhegan Plantation in said School for the single school year beginning September _____ and ending August _____ subject to the conditions stated below.

In accordance with the applicable salary schedule of the Plantation, the Committee has voted and hereby agrees to pay said teacher, and said teacher hereby requests and agrees to accept, for service during the above-stated period, an annual salary rate of \$ _____ in 12 installments, payable as follows: \$ _____ beginning September _____ less any deductions required by State or Federal law, proper deductions for loss of time, and other mutually-agreed-to deductions which the teacher may in writing, authorize.

The teacher agrees at all times, during the life of this contract, to hold valid state certification which authorizes the teaching of the subjects or fields to which the teacher is assigned and to perform all assigned duties diligently, professionally and efficiently in accordance with all laws, rules and regulations, subject to the direction of the School Committee and the Superintendent of Schools.

It is understood, further, that other assignments may be made, without additional compensation, to those other duties which constitute the non-instructional responsibilities of the teacher.

The right is reserved by the School Committee, acting through the Superintendent, to make such reasonable changes in instructional and non-instructional assignments as are deemed to be in the best interest of the Plantation.

This contract is subject to the statutes of the State of Maine and the rules and regulations of the School Committee. It may be terminated by mutual consent at any time and may be terminated by the School Committee as provided by statute.

The teacher may resign by submitting at least sixty (60) days written notice at any time except during the month of August; provided, however, that during the first year of employment, a teacher may not resign prior to the official opening of school.

This offer of contract on the part of the School Committee shall be void unless a copy duly executed by the teacher is received by the Superintendent of Schools on or before _____.
