

Purpose: To fulfill the school's responsibility of identifying all children between the ages of three and 20 within its jurisdiction who may be students with disabilities.

Child Find screening shall be accomplished through the efforts of the Midcoast Child Development Services which advertises and works with the local medical community to locate the 3-5 year old population of students with disabilities. Referrals are accepted from other professionals and persons with knowledge of the child. This information is then communicated to the Superintendent.

Students who transfer to Monhegan School will have their records reviewed by the Superintendent or designee. This screening of records will determine if the student has already been receiving special education or whether the student should be referred to the Pupil Evaluation Team for a more comprehensive review.

Documentation of such screening shall be included in the student's cumulative file.
