To enter Kindergarten, a child must be five (5) years old on or before October 15th of the year of entrance. A student who does not meet this minimum age requirement, may be accepted to enroll if the child meets the screening requirements defined in JFAAA and the school has capacity in terms of both sufficient staffing and facilities to accommodate the additional student(s) in early-Kindergarten. A child who will be six (6) years old at that time and who has not attended Kindergarten or its equivalent shall be enrolled in Kindergarten. If, as a result of tests and in the opinion of the teacher and parents, such a child appears able to handle first grade work he may be passed to the first grade.
