The School Committee shall:

- A. Adopt policies to govern the operation of the K-8 school and provide education to secondary school students from Monhegan;
- B. Take specific actions as required by law;
- C. Cooperate with the Superintendent elected by the School Committee and approved by the State Commissioner of Education;
- D. Appoint substitute teachers as necessary;
- E. Oversee all school finances;
- F. Act in case of teacher absences or grievance procedures concerning the teacher;
- G. Take action when expulsion of a pupil may have to be considered;
- H. Take such action as is required by law and Monhegan School policy for the high school education of Monhegan children;
- I. Develop the school calendar yearly and designate the hours which shall constitute a regular school day;
- J. Sanction school field trips;
- K. Make provisions, and if necessary rules, for the use of the school building for non-school functions;
- L. Encourage discussions between administration, parents, teachers and pupils.

The School Committee will take as a primary source of guidance the booklet issued by the State Department of Education entitled, "Duties and Functions of Superintending School Committees".
